
Dear Nick:

This follows up on our recent telephone conversations and e-mail exchanges regarding the above-referenced matter and the construction schedule for the Honolulu High-Capacity Transit Corridor Project ("Project"). In our previous discussions, you agreed that the Plaintiffs would provide notice to the Defendants in advance of Plaintiffs seeking any injunctive relief. On behalf of the City Defendants, I agreed that we would provide notice to the Plaintiffs prior to implementing any change to the Project construction schedule to advance the date of construction of the Project. As we previously advised you in our letter dated June 23, 2011, utility relocation and right-of-way acquisition work is ongoing.

The following is the currently proposed construction schedule for the Project, with no construction to occur for these matters before the dates indicated. These dates reflect the anticipated beginning of work in the field:
